I want to update you on some changes that will take place at Brant Christian starting in September. The grade 5/6 class will become a homeroom-centered class. This means that they will be instructed in Math, Science, LA, Social and Bible by one teacher. My reasons for making this change are varied. By keeping this class with one teacher, the students will be better organized; instructions, assignments, tests and homework will be more easily coordinated and appropriate for their age group. With this set-up, I believe a greater unity will develop in the class.

Her small teaching load and work at the University of Calgary made it difficult for her to become fully engaged in our school. She is looking forward to having the time to get to know the students and parents better and being involved in extra-curricular activities.
